**Entry Deadline:** Pre-entry is highly encouraged as the number of shooters will be limited to 48 (Six relays). Entry deadline is 5/10/23. Assignment of relays will be on a "first come, first served basis". If you are shooting with a partner, please indicate that on your entry form.

**Entry Requirements:** Proof of CRPA membership is required to shoot this match. CRPA membership application forms are included with the entry form. Competitors are encouraged to join prior to the match but may join at the time you check in with the Statistics Official. A 3-Day Non-Resident CRPA membership is required for a \$20 fee.

**Course of Fire:** These matches will be fired in a squadded fashion as per NRA Rule 1.7(g). Course of fire will be conducted per NRA Rifle Silhouette Rules. Target color will be florescent orange.

**Thursday May 25, 2023:** The range will be available for sight-in and practice of all shooting events from 10:00 a.m. to dusk.

<u>Friday, May 26, 2023</u> will be **Smallbore Cowboy Rifle.** This championship will consist of two 40 round matches with an aggregate of 80 rounds for the championship. A shooters meeting will be held at 7:30 a.m. The morning match will be called to the line at 8:00 a.m. and the afternoon match will commence after a short lunch break.

<u>Saturday, May 27, 2023</u> will be <u>Lever Action - Pistol Cartridge Rifle</u>. This championship will consist of two 40 round matches with an aggregate of 80 rounds for the championship. A shooters meeting will be held at 7:30 a.m. The morning match will be called to the line at 8:00 a.m. and the afternoon match will commence after a short lunch break.

<u>Sunday, May 28, 2023</u> will be <u>Lever Action Centerfire Rifle Cartridge</u>. This championship will consist of two 40 round matches with an aggregate of 80 rounds for the championship. A shooters meeting will be held at 7:30 a.m. The morning match will be called to the line at 8:00 a.m. and the afternoon match will commence after a short lunch break.

<u>Classifications:</u> Any shooter entering a match who is unclassified will compete in the highest class offered. After the first match the shooter will be classified per their first match score.

<u>Saturday Dinner</u>: There will be a Saturday evening dinner provided by the Hat Creek Rifle and Pistol Club at no charge. There is a line on the entry form to note number of dinners desired. At this time there will be no lunch service available at the range.

**Safety:** All NRA and Hat Creek Rifle & Pistol Club, Inc. rules will be strictly enforced. Failure to comply will cause disqualification. Eye and Ear Protection in the immediate area of the firing line is mandatory. Open Bolt Indicators are mandatory. Consumption of alcoholic beverages or any other mind-altering agent by competitors during the competition is not allowed.

**Equipment:** Equipment must conform to NRA Rule #3.1.3

<u>Ties:</u> Ties for each championship match aggregate will be broken by a shoot off per NRA Rule 15.3(a). Other ties will be broken by reverse animal count from Rams to Chickens per NRA rule 15.3(b), and if still tied, by a coin toss.

<u>Match Officials and Jury:</u> The names of the match officials, including a three-person jury, will be posted at the state championship site. In the case of a protest of match results the decision of the named jury will be final.

**Practice:** The range will be open for practice on Thursday May 25, 2023 from 10:00 a.m. until dusk.

**Awards:** Awards for each day's 80 shot aggregate match will be given for all classes, Master through B, for each day. Three Champions will be named, one for each day of matches. Special Class awards will be given to high Grand Senior, High Woman, High Senior, and High Junior. Grand Senior, Senior, Woman, and Junior special classes must be declared in advance and may compete in only one such category. An overall three-day aggregate winner (total of all three disciplines) will be named. There will be team awards for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place. Five and ten in-a-row pins will be awarded, except for AAA and Master will only receive ten in-a-row pins (if requested by the competitor). Awards will be presented at the conclusion of each day's matches.

**Teams**: Three member teams may be formed prior to the beginning of that day's matches.

<u>Facilities:</u> Overnight camping, starting Wednesday, May 24, 2023 is permitted at no charge. There is no charge for the practice day on Thursday. Campsites are unimproved. Bring your own food & water. No open campfires are permitted. Portable toilets are available. Children must always be under the supervision of an adult. Pets must be on a leash. Motels and RV parks are available in Burney and Fall River Mills. See information below.
